SNOW REMOVAL POLICY

PURPOSE:

To give the citizens of New Haven Township a realistic expectation of snow and ice removal services that will be provided during the winter season.

GOAL:

The general goal of Michael Wood, LLC is to keep the township roads passable during the most heavily travelled periods of the week. Roads are prioritized by traffic volume and logical routing pattern.

OPERATIONAL GUIDELINES:

The first priority is to make ALL roads passable. Once all roads are passable, the roads will be widened and abrasive/chemical mixture applied if necessary. Finally, additional clean up will be done, if time allows, before the next snow. Hours of operation will be determined by weather conditions and/or traffic volume. If the Weather Service has recommended no travel, it is assumed that there will be low traffic volume, resulting in a lower level of service. Operations will be halted when conditions are too hazardous or if reasonable accomplishments cannot be made.

ABANDONED VEHICLES:

New Haven Township and Michael Wood LLC, will not be responsible for damage to vehicles parked on township roads during snow emergencies.
