

**RESOLUTION REQUESTING A
MNDOT SPEED ZONE STUDY ON NEW HAVEN ROAD NW
NORTH OF THE INTERSECTION WITH CO RD 5**

New Haven Township, Olmsted County, Minnesota – Resolution #2017-17

WHEREAS, traffic on New Haven Road NW, commencing at the intersection with Co Rd 5 continuing to the City of Pine Island (hereinafter “New Haven Road”), has increased dramatically since the opening of the Pine Elementary School; and

WHEREAS, additional traffic on New Haven Road is anticipated once Co Rd 5 is completed east to the intersection with Highway 52; and

WHEREAS, New Haven Road is a winding gravel country road which previously served mainly rural residents and the farming community; and


WHEREAS, public safety problems have been reported with traffic volumes, traffic speeds, and dust on New Haven Road; and

WHEREAS, the New Haven Town Board wishes to increase the public safety for residents and the traveling public on New Haven Road; and


WHEREAS, the New Haven Town Board wishes to find alternatives to closing the New Haven Road to through traffic;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the New Haven Township Board of Supervisors request an engineering/traffic study to determine if a 25 MPH speed limit is reasonable and safe for New Haven Road NW, commencing at the intersection with Co Rd 5 continuing to the City of Pine Island.


